What reason did Moses give for God to not destroy the Israelites? (verses 11-13)

What did Moses do to the golden calf? (verse 20)

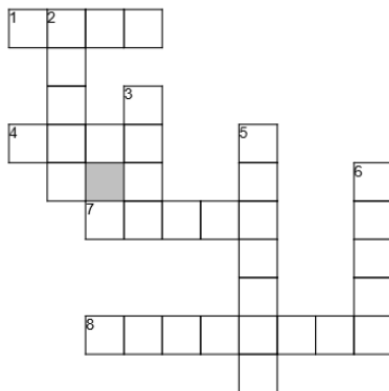
Read and Praise God: 1 Samuel 2:2

GOD RULES.

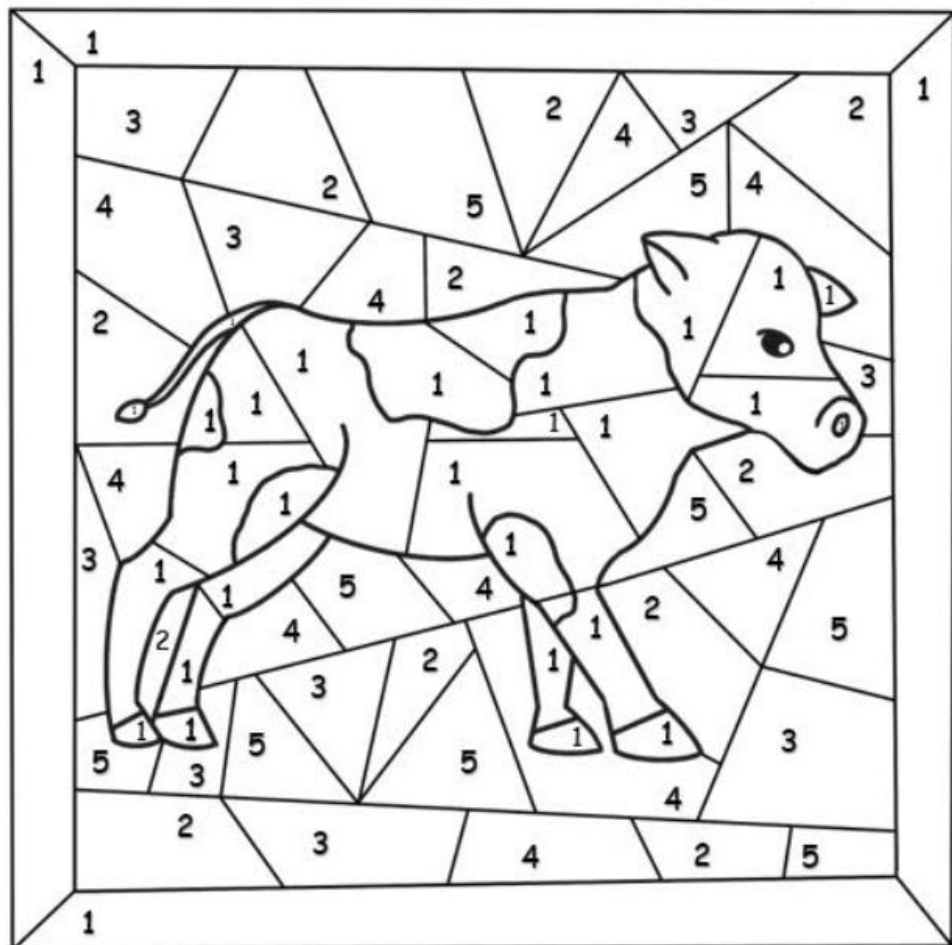


WE RESPOND.

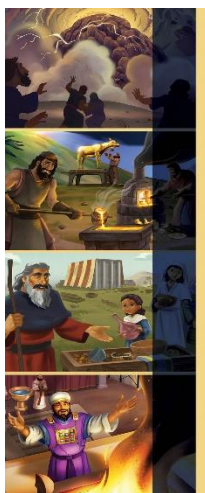
